- 4. The Centre will purchase a reputable brand of SPF 30+ broad spectrum, water resistant sun screen (suitable for use on young children) for use by children and staff while they are at the centre
- 5. Parents providing their child with their own sunscreen from home need to provide a pharmacist
- 6. During the months 1st August to 30th April educators will supervise application of sunscreen to children 20 minutes before each outside play session and regularly reapply (around two hourly) if outside for an extended period of play or during water activities when the UV rating at the Centre reaches 3 and above.
- 7. Educators will encourage children to wear hats when outside and will ensure that children wear hats when outdoors 1st August to 30th April and whenever the UV is 3 and above at other times. Children not wearing hats or appropriate clothing will remain in fully sun-protected areas when outdoors.
- 8. Exposure to the sun during harmful hours, during peak UV times from 1st August to 30th April, and when the UV is 3 and above outside these times, will be minimised by setting up outdoor activities in shaded areas or scheduling outside these times as much as possible.
- 9. For Work Health and Safety and role modelling, educators, students and volunteers (including parents and visitors) are required to apply sunscreen, wear appropriate hats, clothes and seek shade when outdoors when the UV is 3 and above. Families and visitors are encouraged to use a combination of sun protection measures when participating in or attending outdoor events.
- 10. The Centre will incorporate age appropriate sun and skin protection awareness into the program.
- 11. The Centre will regularly reinforce and promote SunSmart Behaviour to the whole community (via newsletters, brochures and displayed information) and all families and staff will be informed of the policy.
