Selection of Candidate

- 5. The Prize shall be awarded annually to the candidate who completed the best essay or Honours thesis in Shakespearean and Elizabethan Studies as determined by the Head, Department of English, Creative Writing and Film (or nominee).
- 6. If the Prize is not awarded in any year, then the available income distribution shall be added to the capital sum in the Endowment Fund.
- 7. If the Head of Department (or nominee) determines that two or more essays/theses are of equal merit, the Prize may be divided equally among the candidates.

Administration and Variations

- 8. The Prize will be administered by the Coursework Scholarships and Prizes Office.
- 9. The University may vary the rules from time to time in a manner consistent with the University's legal obligations and policies.
- 10. The University reserves the right to withdraw the Prize if the Student Misconduct Tribunal has found the student guilty of misconduct and imposed a relevant penalty, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information that has a relationship to the awarding of this Prize in accordance with the University's Policies, Rules and Statutes for Student Misconduct.
- 11. Once the Prize has been withdrawn for that year, it may be re-awarded to the next eligible student at the discretion of the Department and subject to available funding.
