History Of The Vineyard

In February 2003, the Croser family purchased Maylands Farm at Parawa on the Southern Fleurieu Peninsula, just 8 kilometres from the Great Southern Ocean to the South. Maylands Farm was purchased with the specific intention of growing the finest "sea air, grass fed" prime lambs.

A review of the climate statistics and the slope geology and soil features of the farm

Perfect small bunches of Pinot Noir were hand harvested on the 12th and 13th of March and transported to the Petaluma winery in the Piccadilly Valley about one hour north of Foggy Hill.

The three clones were destemmed, crushed and chilled separately
