

Frank Pearson (RDA, 1925) graduated from Roseworthy Agricultural College with First Class Honours then gained broad experience working for winemaker Walter Reynell, Cresco Fertilizers, Electrolytic Zinc Co in Tasmania and then sharefarming with his father at Angle Vale before enlisting in the army in 1940. Following active service in Tobruk and El Alamein, he was wounded, hospitalised and discharged in 1943. He then joined
