

John Obst (RDA, 1960) graduated from Roseworthy with Honours and followed this with a BRurSci in 1964 and a MRurSci in 1969 from the University of New England, Armidale. Four years later, in 1973, he was granted a PhD from the University of Adelaide, Department of Animal Physiology at the Waite Research Institute.

For the next seven years, John was involved with basic research associated with ovine and bovine reproductive physiology, initially at the Struan Research Centre of the South Australian Department of Agricult
