

Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Descent Declaration Form

At the University of Adelaide under the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Descent Declaration Act 1988 (Cth) for people of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander origins. Wiltu Yarluk requires applicants to provide confirmation of their origins when applying for Indigenous-specific higher education services such as:

- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Access
- Indigenous Student Services
- Accommodation and Housing Services
- Indigenous Scholarships

Applicants need to either provide a copy of their Certificate of Aboriginality OR complete the attached 'Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Descent Declaration' form.

An Australian Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander is someone who:

- is of Aboriginal and/or Islander descent
- identifies as Aboriginal or Islander; and
- is accepted as such by the community in which he or she lives or has lived.

As the declaration requires the applicant to provide a copy of their Certificate of Aboriginality OR complete the attached 'Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander Descent Declaration' form.
